Evaluate...

When asked a question using the 'evaluate' command term, your response should be organized and structured to address the question prompt which is asking you to make an assessment. To evaluate is to 1. analyze and 2. make judgment. To ensure that your response to the question is structured and organized, as a rule of thumb, your answer should be divided into 4 paragraphs.

- The 1st paragraph of your answer should show that you have a clear understanding of the demand of the question by clearly explaining and defining the economic concept in question.
- Paragraphs 2 & 3 should be your analysis, with a minimum of 3 points for each analysis, numbering each point for clarity.
- The last and final paragraph should contain your evaluation, your judgment, your conclusion, recommendation, etc.

Paragraph 2

- 1. Advantages
- 2. Stakeholder 1
- 3. Short-term impact

Paragraph 3

- 1. Disadvantages
- 2. Stakeholder 2
- 3. Long-term impact
